$$\int_0^1 \left( \frac{\ln x}{(1+x^2)^2} - 3\sqrt{x} \right) dx = -\frac{G}{2} - \frac{\pi}{8} - \frac{1}{2} \quad (2)$$

❖ Catalan constant:  $G = 0.91596559\dots$

❖ Pi constant:  $\pi = 3.14159265\dots$

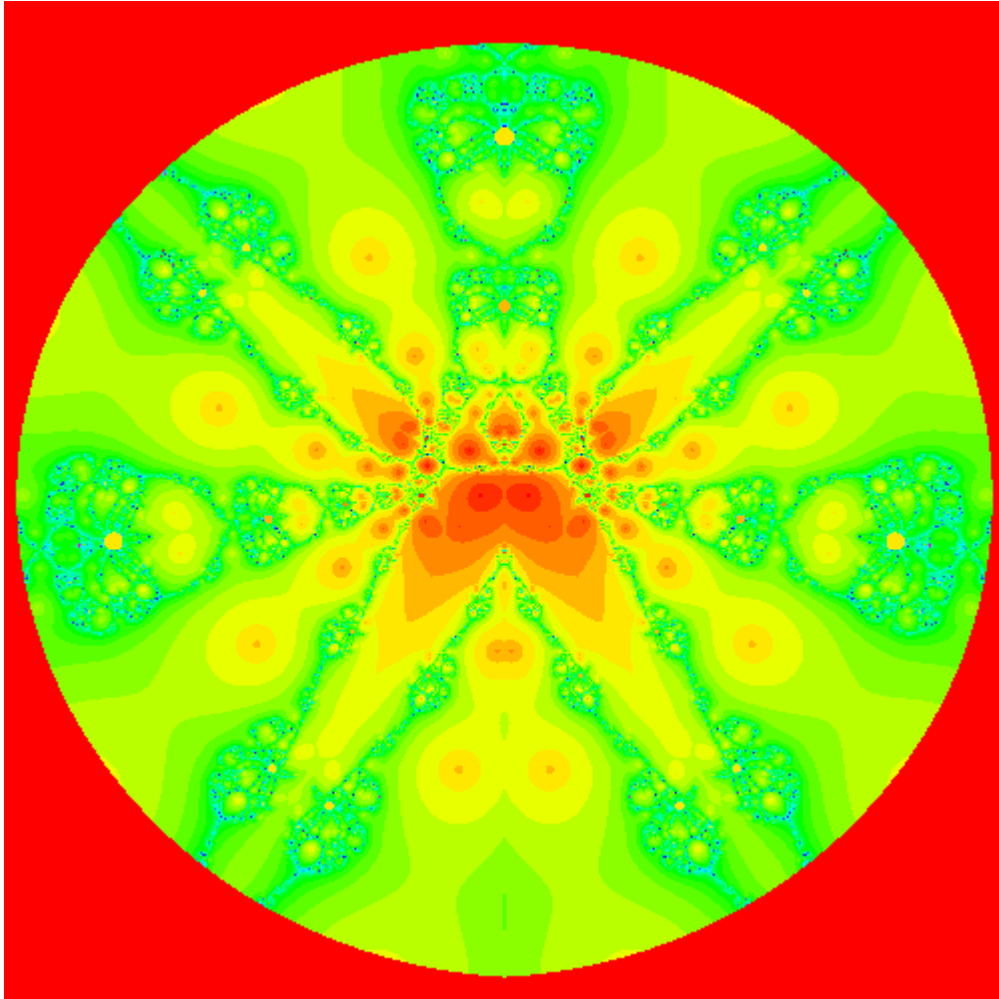

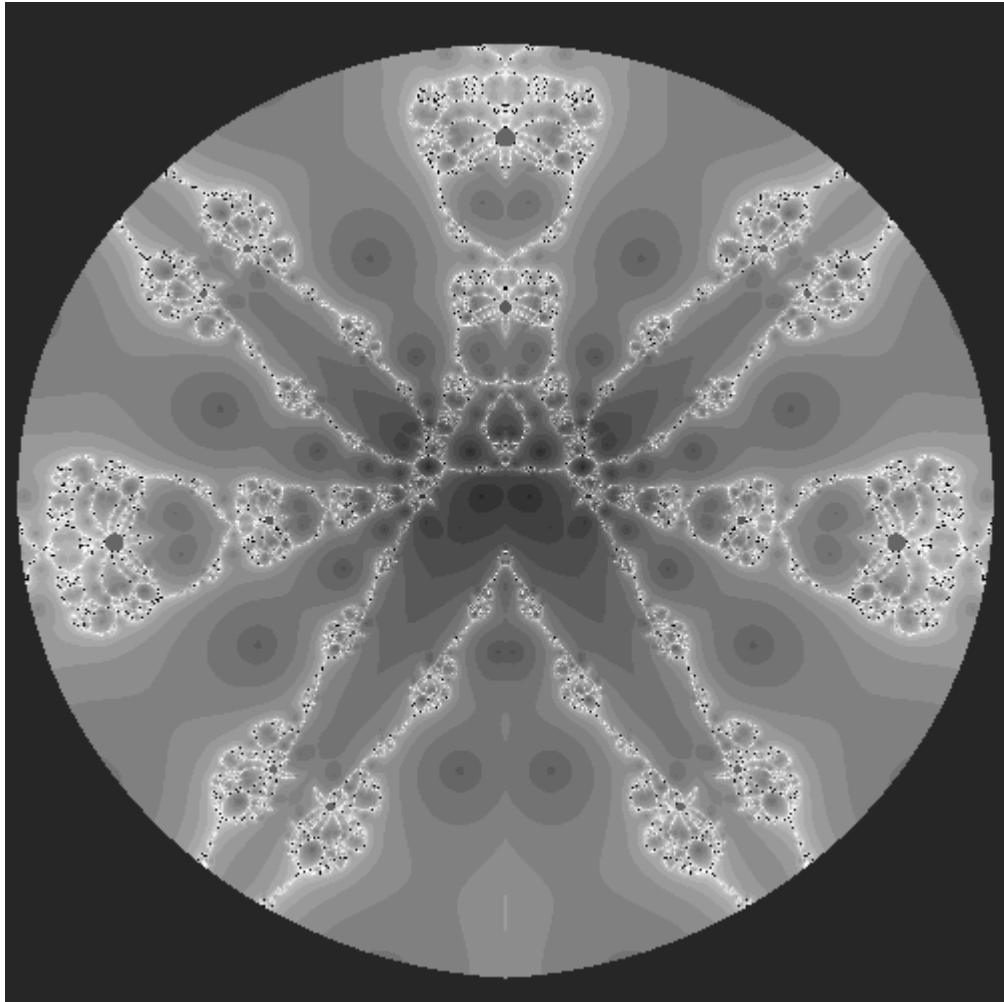

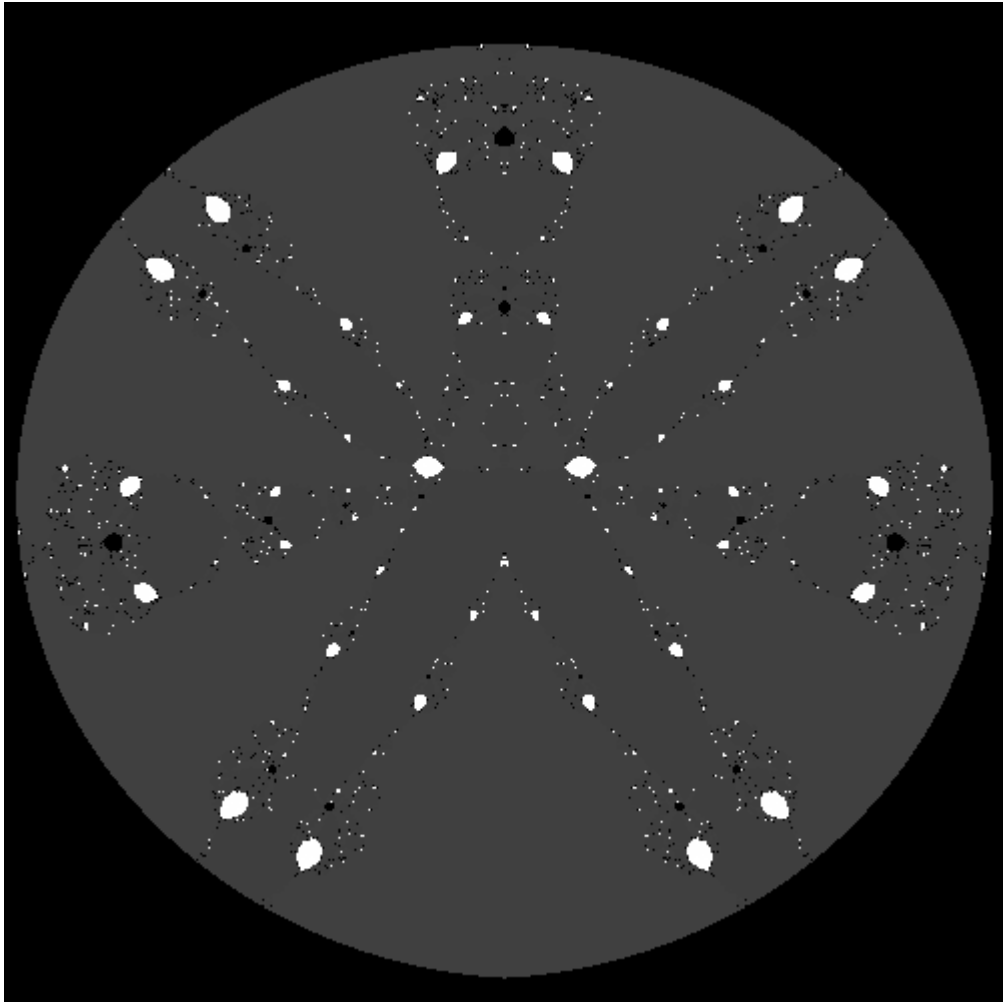

❖ Newton fractals for  $g(z) = \frac{\ln z}{(1+z^2)^2} - 3\sqrt{z}$ .

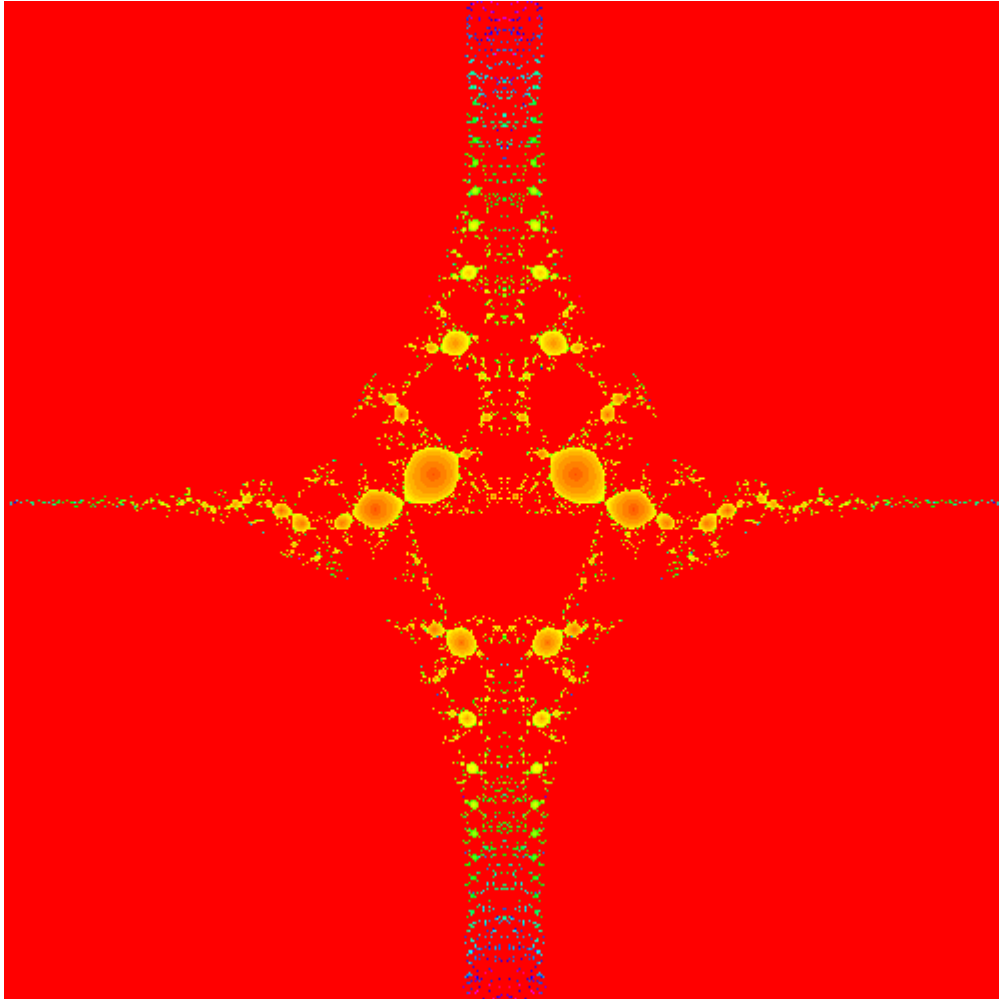

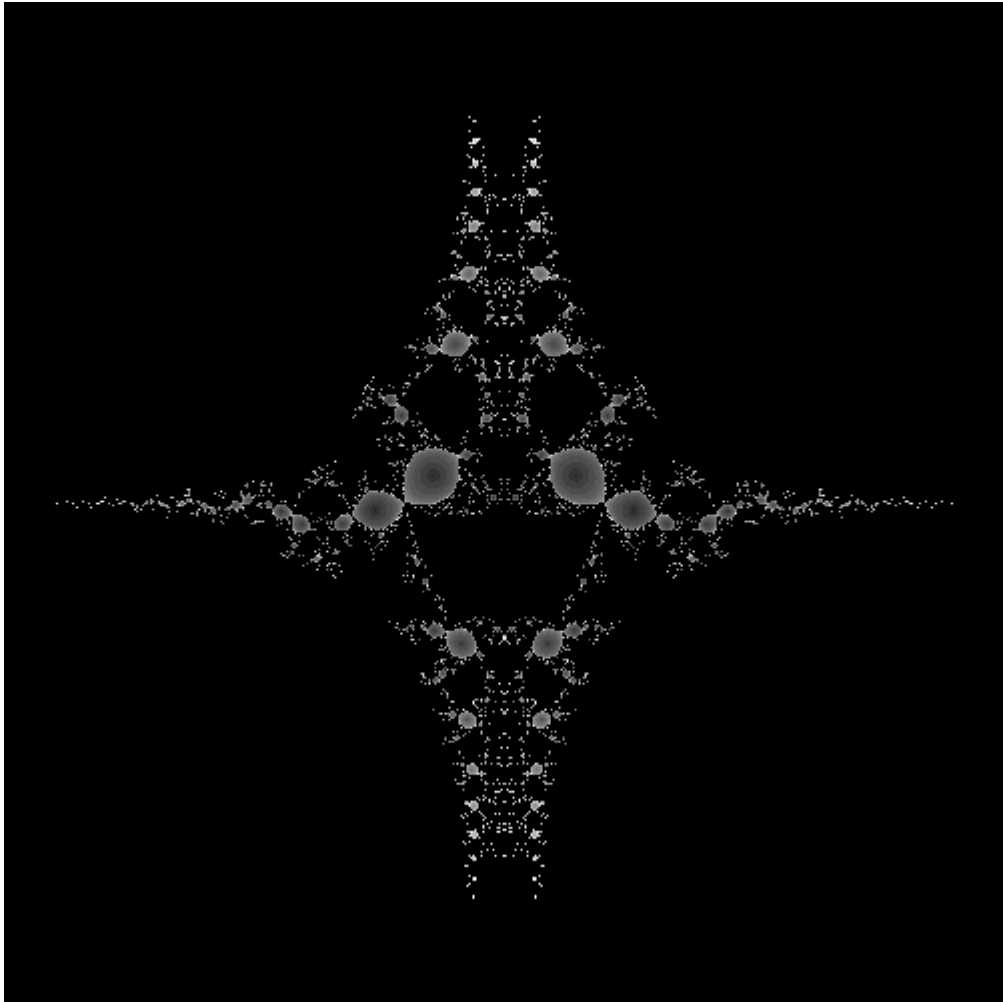

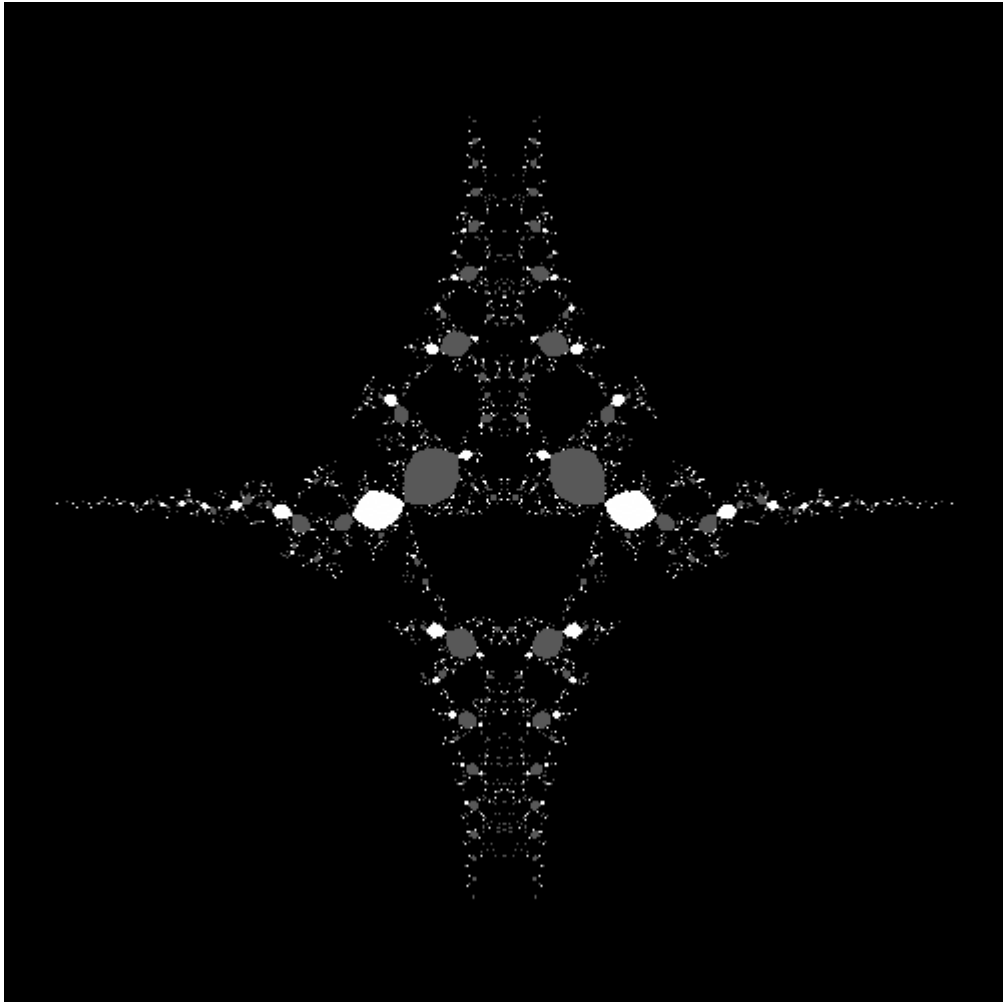
